Statewide LAT Co-ordinators/Representatives

Participate in LAT Conference Calls

Localize and Distribute LAT messages to their areas.

LAT Reps will be “point of Contact” on Legislative issues for their area.

LAT Reps & other GSMOL/HOA leaders cultivate relationships with local officials.
